*For ease of use, information is presented as relevant to each participant.*

### **JUNIOR PLAYERS**

- BYO labelled drink bottle and sanitiser
- No hugs, high fives or unnecessary contact
- Arrive NO earlier than 10 minutes before your game
- Enter through marked double gates and Exit via single gates
- Leave as soon as your game ends
- Get in, play your game, get out

## COACHES

- BYO labelled drink bottle and sanitiser
- Wear your green wristband (identifies you as an Official who will be recorded on the scoresheet)
- Record your contact details on the scoresheet
- Remind players to avoid unnecessary contact (no high fives, hugs)
- Limit bib changes
- Don't use bibs for more than 1 team
- Wipe all equipment after each game (including goal post)
- Maintain 1.5m distance at all times

### HOME TEAM SCORERS

- BYO pen
- BYO labelled drink bottle and sanitiser
- Wear your green wristband (identifies you as an Official who will be recorded on the scoresheet)
- Record contact details of coaches, players and any other officials(you) on scoresheet
- Collect scoresheet from Pavilion (boards disinfected in between each game)
- Return scoresheet to marked tub in pavilion
- Remind those parent/guardians who must attend, to stand away from the court in groups of no more than 10, maintaining 1.5m distance
- Don't ask Umpires to sign scoresheet or select Best & Fairest votes
- Use disinfectant wipes to wipe over goal post padding – ask Away Team to help.

### CLUB COMMITTEE MEMBERS

- BYO labelled drink bottle and sanitiser
- Read and understand all NV resources
- Share NV Member guidelines with your members
- Ensure your members have current NV membership
- Share all FDNA instructions and support FDNA protocols
- Instruct your members not to “hang around” in Pavilion. Place bags if necessary, don’t spend time in there (limited to 20 people)
- Distribute green wristbands to Club officials (identifies Officials who will be recorded on the scoresheet)
- Communicate that people wearing wristbands must record their contact details on a scoresheet (including YOU)
- Advise members that spectators are not allowed and parents who must attend should wait away from the courts.

### PARENT/GUARDIANS

- Prepare your child according to instructions for Players
- BYO labelled drink bottle and sanitiser
- Ensure your child's Netball Victoria membership is current
- Avoid entering the court area if possible
- If you must enter the courts, you **MUST** have your contact details recorded at the entry gates by FDNA staff
- If waiting in the court area stand away from the courts' edge with no more than 9 others
- Enter and Exit via specifically marked gates
- Leave the courts as soon as the game ends and do not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes before your game
- Maintain 1.5m distance at all times
