

# TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

## Check In

All Teams & Umpires must check in upon arrival at the Reception desk located inside the main entrance to the Jubilee Park Stadium.

## Umpires

Each Team entered is required to supply their own Umpire for the Tournament. Team Umpires are to umpire per the fixtured matches for their allocated team and arrive at the court on time. All umpires are obligated to stay and officiate if their nominated team is participating in finals.

## Rolling Subs

Rolling substitutions are permitted in all age groups. Only one rolling substitute per team can be made at a time. The players must tag hands as they roll on & off the court. The substitution must take place away from play & must not interfere with the umpires. Players must observe the offside rules as they enter/leave the court.

## Scoring

The first named team is required to score, second named team to provide a scorer to stand together on the sideline opposite the centre circle.

## Centre Pass

First named Team to take the first centre pass and the second named Team may choose goal end.

## Fixtures, Results & Ladders

Fixtures, results and ladders will be published online on Netball Connect. In the event of a draw each team will be awarded 2 points each.

A Player may **NOT** transfer to another team once the Tournament has commenced.

## First Aid

First Aid will be available on the day. Ice packs and treatment available in the Physio room located next to reception inside the stadium.

## Blood/ Injury on Court

Umpires may hold time for an injury or blood on court, however no extra time will be added for centrally timed matches. If blood or injury is noted, the player will leave the court within & up to 30 seconds and may return (i) after a goal has been scored if no substitution has been made. (ii) immediately following an interval or stoppage for injury or illness. Refer to Rules of Netball (2020) 9.1.

## Finals

The first named team to take the centre pass and second named team may choose the goaling end. In the event of a draw there will be a 1-minute break. Teams will play extra time of 3 minutes at each end with a straight swap of ends in between. In the event of a **SECOND DRAW**, play will continue until 1 team has a 2-goal advantage.

## Presentations

Presentations for 11U teams will be held after the last scheduled round in an allocated area to be determined on the day. Presentations for Premiers & Runners Up for 13U, 15U & 17U will be held at the conclusion of the Grand Finals in each Division.
